We thought we would have another RV soon following, but that did not happen. But, God is faithful. On April 11, 2018, we bought a 1996 40 foot Foretravel motorhome. We are sure this is the one God wanted us to have. After purchasing, I took it to Camping World to have 43 point inspection and the tech wrote on report, unit is in excellent condition.

During the process of getting the loan to make the purchase, the Lord and I had some long discussions. In the natural it made no sense to do what I did. I'm in the third quarter of life. By April, we had held one revival. The slate is not filled solid. I woke up one night at 3 am and said Lord what am I doing? If I ever heard the Lord speak, I did that night. He said clearly, “Pat, trust me.” So, the case was closed. “What is impossible, with man, is possible with God.” When doors close, God can open them. When man says retire, God says you are called to “go.” We have chosen to continue to do it God's way and go where the doors open.

We had three revivals in May and God blessed abundantly. We were first at Indianapolis, IN, Cornerstone. We had been there several times. This time they were without a pastor, They attended faithfully and God blessed and met many needs. We started Cornerstone on Wednesday and closed out Sunday morning. Then Monday we moved 40 miles to Greensboro, IN, and had revival there Monday through Friday. Rev. Perry was the pastor and had only been there for a few weeks. On Tuesday night a lady attended that was not a regular attendee. She did not come to the altar but after the service she just could not leave. The Holy Spirit was moving. In her pew, several ladies gathered around her, and she was gloriously saved. And, she was back every service.

Saturday we moved 100 miles to Ft. Wayne, Ind (Elmhurst) and started there Sunday and went over Wednesday. God blessed. Sunday morning as I was about to start preaching, a young man came in and sat on back row. God was in the service. As I opened the altar for anyone to come that had a need, that man walked the center isle. He was gloriously saved by God's amazing grace. He began to share his story to the church. He was 28 years old. This was the first time he had been in a church service since he was young attending VBS. He was desperate for help. The church is the place to run to. Four weeks earlier, the pastor, who lives on church property, was outside and the man, whom he had never seen, asked the pastor to pray with him. But the pastor knew very little about him. His wife had left him and their four children. A 8 year old daughter had been battling cancer for 2 years and was currently in the hospital. For reasons I am not aware of, she had not spoken a word for months. Sunday morning we anointed him with oil and the church prayed for God's healing power to touch his daughter. He came back Tuesday to report that his daughter had spoken. She said “daddy.” He was thrilled. Pastor planted the seed. I had the privilege to water it. And God gave the increase. To God be all the praise and the glory!

The days of revival are here. People still need the Lord. The good news is, Jesus still saves, sanctifies, heals, delivers and meets the needs of people that trust and obey Him. Many

people are hopeless. Have given up. Don't think their life can be changed. Many Christians are struggling. The need for revival is great. But, God is greater.
